Meta launched Muse Image yesterday — free, inside Instagram and WhatsApp, better quality than Google's Nano Banana 2, and in weeks it will auto-generate your ad creative variations.

On July 7, 2026, Meta launched Muse Image — a free AI image generator available directly inside Meta AI, Instagram, and WhatsApp. Meta's internal benchmarks show it beats Google's Nano Banana 2 on image quality, and the company announced that within weeks, it will start auto-generating ad creative variations for businesses running campaigns on its platforms. You type a prompt; it ships production-quality images to your feed or your ads without leaving the app.

Do it: Open WhatsApp or Instagram, use Meta AI to generate branded images with your business colors and message, export directly to your feed or Stories. Zero cost, zero design skill.

Where DIY stops: Custom illustration styles, exact brand-guideline color matching, and high-res print output still need a designer or a professional tool like Midjourney or Photoshop. This is fast social content, not brand-book artwork.
